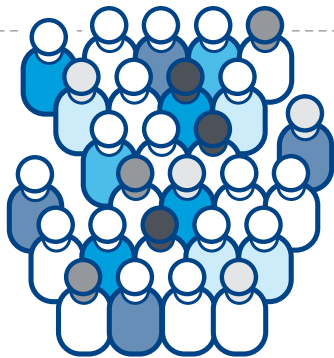


Program Overview

The goal of Barrow neurorehabilitation specialists is to help patients have a better quality of life through therapies that help to improve skills, independence, and self-esteem after a spinal cord injury. Specific criteria are identified and must be met to qualify a patient for admission.

Intensity of Services/ Participation Requirements

- Therapy services provided five to seven days a week
- Average of three hours of therapy per day, Monday through Friday with additional therapy on Saturday and Sunday
- Medical stability/absence of medical problems that would interfere with participation in therapies
- Must be able to demonstrate progress towards meeting established team discharge goals
